Weekly Standards/Concepts

- **Math-** We are learning basic flat shapes: square, triangle, rectangle, oval, circle and diamond. We are also exploring shapes in our environment.
- **Fundations-** We are learning our letters/picture and sounds the letters make and how to form letters. So far we have learned t, b and f.
- **Handwriting** This week is the lowercase letter "t"., "b" and "f" ...next week is lowercase "m" and "n".
- Reading- This week we focused on Characters and Setting in a story. Next week we will learn about events in order of the story.
- **Social Studies** We are learning about Character, The Pledge of Allegiance and the Star Spangled Banner. Next week we start Science: Our Five Senses.
- Writing- This week we are learning to state an opinion and the teacher dictates students' response. This week we discussed what our opinion was based on the question: What is your favorite restaurant?"
